Refugee Employment Services For Clients

You are eligible for employment services if you have been resettled to Houston as a refugee and are a current client of the YMCA receiving assistance through the Matching Grant or RCA programs. You may also be eligible if you are a victim of human trafficking, asylee, or parolee and you have been in the US for less than five (5) years.

Our goal is to help you find a job as quickly as possible and become self-sufficient. Services are provided free of charge and include:

- Pre-screening
- Case Management
- Job Counseling
- Pre-employment workshops
- Vocational Training
- Professional recertification

To enroll in our services please bring ALL of your documents including:

- I-94
- Social security card
- Employment Authorization Document (EAD)
- Texas ID or Texas drivers license
