PARIS BASIS

Adopted 22nd August 1855 in Paris, France at the 1st World YMCA Conference

Rooted in its Christian mission, the YMCA has always been dedicated to fostering faith, unity, and service. This commitment was formally expressed in the Paris Basis of 1855, which defines the organization's guiding principles:

"The Young Men's Christian
Associations seek to unite those
young men who, regarding Jesus
Christ as their God and Savior,
according to the Holy Scriptures,
desire to be his disciples in their
faith and in their life, and to
associate their efforts for the
extension of his Kingdom amongst
young men.

Any differences of opinion on other subjects, however important in themselves, shall not interfere with the harmonious relations of the constituent members and associates of the World Alliance."
